

Education Of Campers

Arthur Meehan, charter member of the Communist Party, said at an address that the campers at Camp Unity this year display an unusual interest in the great economic and political problems facing the world.

"They are a reflection of the awakening of the American people to the great problems facing Russia," he says, turning his head through his slouch of camouflage hat.

"Campers show a great eagerness to learn—not only about present events but to learn the correct historical—Leninist—approach to an end to bourgeois society—the events which follow the struggle with such lightning-like rapidity.

"The camp is the site of rigorous but always friendly discussions. There are sections at the camp of various shades of political opinion."

Meehan, in addition to serving as educational director of the camp, is secretary of the New York State Training schools which are run this year round. They last September he has conducted four full-time schools and three evening schools.
