Britain Uses Jews as Puppets as Arabs Struggle for Independence

Bankrupt in its promises and stripped of every pretention, the Zionist leaders in America have been forced again to resort to a violent and demonstrably false anti-Communist campaign in an effort to save face before the masses of Jewish people.

In the vanguard of the latest Zionist crusade are the Jewish Daily Forward, organ of the notorious "Old Guard" of the Socialist Party, and the Jewish Day, mouthpiece of the professional Zionists.

Both papers burst forth on Saturday with a "proclamation" or leaflet allegedly distributed by the Palestinian Communist Party, The Forward featured the leaflet under its main eight-column streamer reading: "Communists Call Arabe To Pogroms In Palestine." The Day ran the story under the headline: "Communists Renew Incitements Against Jews In Palestine." The cable, as printed in both papers reads:

"TEL AVIV, April 24, - The Palestine Communist Party in Tel Aviv has distributed two proclamations in which they demand 'an end to the bloody Zionist attacks against the Arabs. They assert that "ine Jewish Defense Corps is carrying through They assert that 'the Jewish De-The proclamations close with a call to the Jewish youth 'to struggle together with the Arabian youth for the overthrow of the imperialist government a n d against Zionist attacks,' and with the demand to stop Jewish immigration.' The whole declaration is in the spirit of their declarations after the events of

1929. We send you copies of their proclamations by air-mail."

Leaders Support British

On the basis of this cable, both the Forward and the Day charge the Communists with calling for pogroms against the Jews, and encouraging banditry, firing of homes and outright murder.

An Arab Land

Palestine is a small country of about 10,000 square miles, partly arid and sparsely settled; the rest well-populated. For 1,300 years Palestine has been almost exclusively an Arab land. It must be remembered that Palestine itself is but a small part of the Arabian world. The Arab countries have more than 60,000,000 people. Palestine has a population of only about 1,350,000 including 350,000 Jews.

Until the end of the World War. the chief enemy of Arabian independence was the old Turkish Empire. For 200 years, the Turks ruled over the Arabs. The war shattered the Turkish Empire and brought into being an Arabian national movement.

Promised Independence

British imperialism promised the Arabs independence after the war in teturn for their struggle against the Turks but when the war came to an end, the Arabs were left holding the bag. The Allies divided the land between the Mediterranean Sea and the Persian Gulf into five mandated territories under French and British control. France got Syria and Britain got Palestine. The Arabs had been betrayed.

British imperialism is wise, crafty and utterly ruthless in its colonial (that is, imperialist) policy. The Arabs were hard to hold in leash, Furthermore, even during the war while the British were still fighting the Turks, they had been anxious to gain wider and more active support from influential Jewish circles. At this time, the Arab population in Palestine outnumbered the Jews by more than ten to one. Nevertheless. Balfour refers to it as "the exisiting non-Jewish population." The most important of the civil rights of the Arabs is to self-determination to national independence. That is why they fought on the side of the British during the World War.

"To have a strong, contented Palestine will be, in the future, of incalculable value to the British Empire. From this point of view. Zionism has never been more important than at this moment to Great Britain."
